A DUMB OF CHARME AND HISTORY Located in the fifteenth-century wing of the villa, the apartment is on two levels and preserves intact original architectural and artistic details. The interior spaces offer a sober and refined elegance: Ground floor: welcoming

entrance hall leading to the living area spaces, large and bright kitchen, bathroom. First floor: solon with magnificent fireplace, elegant frescoed master bedroom, large and carefully detailed bathroom. AFFRESTS One of the treasures of this residence are the frescoes painted in 1656 by brothers Giovanni Stefano and Giuseppe Montalto. These works, which decorate some of the apartment's rooms, have undergone a long and careful conservative restoration that lasted three years and has brought back their original colors and most precious details. A WORK BY THE ARCHITECT RICHINI Villa Frisiani Mereghetti, designed by the famous architect Francesco Maria Richini, represents one of the masterpieces of Lombardy's historical heritage. Built in the 17th century on a pre-existing 15th-century nucleus, the villa recounts the vicissitudes of the noble families who inhabited it and preserves unique elements such as coffered ceilings, antique doors and one of the rooms that, according to tradition, hosted St....
